


ONLY WRITE ON THIS BOARD WITH DRY ERASE MARKER!

Wipe off with wet towel once all steps are completed. Wipe or air dry. (Directions for use on back)

Use this board for consistent communication with residents in the home that may benefit from a visual display of schedules and order. This board should be presented BEFORE presenting the required task(s). **ONLY WRITE ON THIS BOARD WITH DRY ERASE MARKER!** DO NOT USE PENS, CRAYONS, ETC. For example, if a resident needs to prepare for school by getting dressed and take medications before eating breakfast, you would write "Get Dressed" in the <u>First</u> box; write "Take Meds" in the <u>Then</u> box; and write "Food" in the "Next" box. If a resident uses pictures to communicate, use the pictures within their communication system OR try to draw photos in the appropriate boxes. Once all steps are completed, clean the board with a wet towel and wipe or air dry.



You would then have this board with you while providing instruction and point to each box. Have the resident repeat this order then stick to the contingency. Remember that all residents have the right to request breaks or refuse to participate in required tasks BUT refusals typically result in not receiving reinforcement. Always refer to behavior plan protocols or contact the behavior analyst for questions.
